Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce that re-enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year will begin on February 15, 2023, for those families whose accounts are up to date. We are asking for you to make your re-enrollment commitment early to help us determine our budget, programming, and staffing needs. **To benefit our families, we will continue to offer a 5% discount when tuition is paid in full at/or by Parent Orientation in August, as well as the family capped cost of \$11,350.00.**

At the December Board meeting, the Board set the tuition, book, and fee rates for the 2023-2024 school year. The decision was made after prayer and carefully considering the effect on family budgets, as well as on the school budget. The Board also took into consideration: previous increases over the last five years, the current inflation rate, the projected inflation rate over the next year, and the potential impact on each family's monthly payment.

With the current inflation rates pushing 7–8%, the Board looked at tuition increases of 3–8%. After prayerful deliberation, the Board chose a 5% increase for the 2023-2024 school year. Raising tuition was a tough call, but it was the right call for Skeels to remain “in the black” and continue to provide a valuable Christian education for our children. On average, your first student will show an increase of about \$19–\$25 per monthly payment. To help families better understand the 2023-2024 tuition costs, we have included the chart below.
